Volunteers

Spelling

Fry spelling words will be checked for "Mastery" in the next week. Your child was tested over the 100 word list during the first full week of school. Any words not mastered, will be quizzed at the end of this week.

Students will also be tested on this week's words that go along with our story: "My Rows and Piles of Coins". This week we are working with prefixes, suffixes, and base/root words.

Reading Street Scores

You should continue seeing your child's results for their weekly "Reading Street" assessment consistently in their planners. The weekly quizzes cover: **Vocabulary**, **Spelling/Phonics**, and **Comprehension**

I encourage you to have your child log on Reading Street and check out their tests to see what they specifically got incorrect.

The steps are:

- 1. Log in to Reading Street.
- 2. Click on the orange "Class" section.
- 3. Click on "Completed".
- 4. Click on what specific test you want to see.

Writing

Our focus for writing is "Personal Narratives". Students will be taking small moments from their lives and writing descriptive retellings of the events. We are developing sentence structure, writing with details, working on logical order, and arranging our ideas into paragraphs. Students will create both written and electronic versions of their writing as they draft their pieces.

Math

Students are currently moving into <u>Unit 2:</u> which focuses on +/- fact families, number stories, regrouping, and solving real world applications. Please continue to practice math facts at home to assist with mastering facts. Record minutes each week to assist with progress monitoring between home and school.

Behavior and Communication
