Stay Informed: Delay or Closing Information

We are getting into that time of year when school delays and closings are more likely to occur. Please remember when severe weather delays or closes school, you can access information you need on the PHM web page at www.phmschools.org

Here's what parents need to know to prepare for closings or delays:

NOTIFICATION

- The notification process is designed to let all members of our community know **no later than 6:00** a.m.
- <u>School Messenger</u>, an automated phone calling and texting service, is our *primary means of notification*. <u>PLEASE VISIT THIS PAGE</u> for steps on how to <u>update your contact information</u> & utilize the new parent portal InfoCenter.
- These local broadcast television stations are informed: ABC 57, WNDU and WSBT.
- The announcement is also posted on the District's website, Facebook, and Twitter

When school is closed, the Prairie Vista office is also closed, so please do not call the school for closing information.

TWO HOUR DELAY SCHEDULE

If we have a 2 hour delay, our doors will open at 9:40 am with a start time at 9:55 am. Please keep in mind that we do not have staff available to supervise before 9:40 am and students will not be let in the building before then. Please make sure you stay informed during this unpredictable time of year!
